- Change of bookings will be subject to availability
- Return the completed form to the centre via email or in paper copy
- We have a "no child technology" policy. All technology brought to the service from home will be kept in the OOSH office until children are picked up. The centre's techlology may be provided at the discretion of the educators
- The Centre opens at 7am and closes at 6pm. A "late pick up fee" of \$2 per minute/per child will be charged for every minute of care after 6pm.
- You will not recieve a confirmation email of your child's booked days as they are automatically placed. If you do recieve an email, it will be to inform you that maximum numbers are reached and are unable to book your child in.
- We are a "Nut Aware" Centre. If your child has a meal/snack that contains nuts, OOSH staff will remove the food item from the centre and replace it with another meal.
